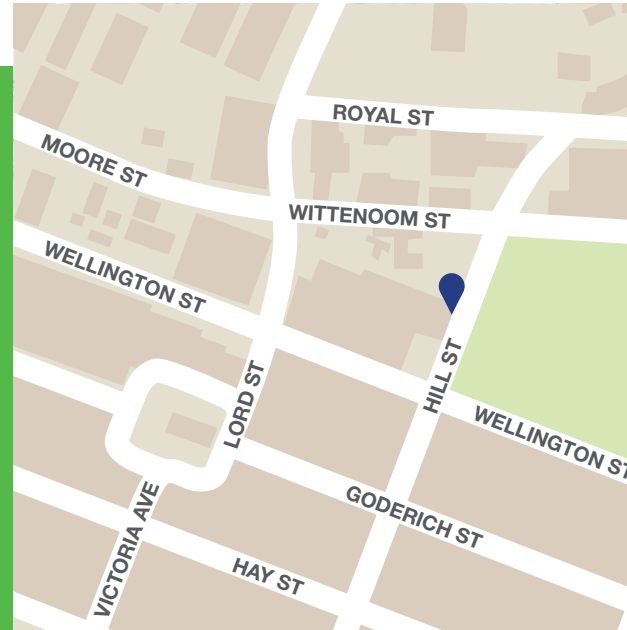

## DRUG & ALCOHOL YOUTH SERVICE

The Integrated Drug & Alcohol Youth Service is a partnership between **Mission Australia** and **Next Step** Drug and Alcohol Services.

The service provides individuals and families with access to a comprehensive range of alcohol and drug services from one location.

**Mission Australia** and **Next Step** provide counselling, rehabilitation, medical and psychological services and support for individuals and their families.



## SERVICES WE PROVIDE

Services provided to young people and their families include:

- Assessment and referral
- Counselling, case management and support
- A two week youth withdrawal and respite service
- A three month residential rehabilitation program (rent charges may apply)
- Transition support including housing
- Medical reviews
- Clinical psychology
- Support for family members including family therapy
- Outreach counselling
- Group programs
- Diversion programs for people referred by the police and courts
- Opiate and alcohol pharmacotherapy treatment
- Shared care with other services



## HOW TO ACCESS OUR SERVICE

People can refer themselves directly or can be referred by other services including mental health, corrective services, child protection and general practitioners.
