The Aboriginal Withdrawal Unit will provide:

- Assistance from specialist medical personnel during the withdrawal process
- One-to-one support, yarning, life skills and group activities
- Referral and liaison with residential rehabilitation agencies and other services as required
- Assistance and referral to financial, social and health support services
- Art activities





There are a number of different services available to Aboriginal people seeking help to address drug and alcohol issues.

Aboriginal Withdrawal Unit







The Aboriginal Withdrawal Unit provides a culturally secure service which meets the needs of Aboriginal people withdrawing from alcohol and/or other drugs.

Staff working on the four-bed unit include doctors, nurses, Aboriginal drug and alcohol workers, and other support professionals.



The service treats people with respect, empathy and understanding whilst taking into account that alcohol and other drug use can affect many different areas of their life.



The staff supports the client to look at the impact that alcohol and other drug use has on themselves, their family and community, and introduces strategies for relapse prevention.

It is also possible to have a designated support person who can reside within the unit or visit on a daily basis.

The unit is smoke free. Nicotine Replacement Therapy will be provided where needed.



Agencies with Aboriginal clients in need of medical withdrawal from drugs and/or alcohol can access the Aboriginal Withdrawal Unit by contacting the Clinical Nurse Specialist to discuss the referral.

Referrals can be made by Drug and Alcohol Services, Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisations or by Government and Non Government Organisations.
