- **Overview:** This course provides a structured, instructor-led pathway to achieving this sought-after qualification within the mental health sector, funded predominantly by the state's Priority Industry Training program.
- **Course Work:** Each unit is completed by a combination of course-work, case studies and ultimately practical application in the workplace. There are no exams.
- **Study Mode / Structure:** For ease of accessibility and convenience, training is provided through two study modes:
  1. **Weekly Training Delivery:** Training is conducted two days a week (Monday-Tuesday, 8:30am – 5pm). This mode is delivery through both in person and virtual classes (virtual for regional students).
  2. **Monthly Training Delivery:** Training is conducted five days a month (week blocks) over a seven month period. Classes will be delivered predominately through virtual classrooms with one week of in person classes offered. Locations of in person training will be based on enrolments. The study experience is designed to be engaging, informative and collaborative, with group activities, case studies and simulations designed to tackle as much of the assessment tasks in class as possible, reducing the amount of homework.
- **Work Placement:** This qualification requires the completion of 80 hours in a suitable workplace, which will be evidenced by way of a log-book. AMA Training Services can assist in finding access to a workplace if required. Where that is the case, the student may require evidence of an up to date flu vaccination and provide a current national police clearance (less than 3 months old).
