

BUDGET BREAKDOWN 2023-24

The 2023-24 State Budget will deliver more than a billion dollars (\$1.358 billion) to mental health, alcohol and other drug services in 2023-24, representing an increase of 7.2% (\$91 million) from the previous budget.
